The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.0123 dated 03.04.2019, under Section 379 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Dharuhera, District Rewari.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR wherein it is alleged that the canter of the complainant was stolen. The petitioner has been arraigned as an accused on the statement of co-accused from whom canter was recovered.

This Court, by the order dated 29.04.2021, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from HC Sunil Kumar, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above, especially when the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 29.04.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
