The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.594 dated 13.11.2020 under Sections 323, 148, 149, 506 IPC (Sections 324, 325, 307, 34 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station City Mohindergarh, District Mohindergarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that no injury is attributed to the petitioner and he is alleged to have caught hold of the injured while co-accused had given him a knife blow. He also contends that the petitioner is in custody for over six months since his arrest on 23.11.2020. The injured has fully recovered from the injury.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Sushil Kumar, contends that a knife was recovered from the petitioner and therefore, he is not entitled to the concession of regular bail. He also contends that although challan has been filed but charges are yet to be framed.

Heard through video-conferencing.

In view of the above especially when the petitioner is in custody for over 06 months, the Covid-19 pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
