This is a petition that has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C.
for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.144, dated
02.10.2020, registered under Section 420 IPC at Police Station Daresi,
District Police Commissionerate Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the matter has been
compromised between the parties.

At this stage, Mr. Ravinderjeet Singh, Advocate, has caused
appearance on behalf of the complainant and has filed his power of attorney,
which is taken on record. He admits the factum of compromise between the
parties.

By an order dated 11.05.2021, this Court had granted interim bail to the petitioner and directed him to join investigation.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent-State, on instructions from ASI Sawinder Singh, submits that petitioner has joined investigation.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation and the matter already stands compromised, the instant petition is allowed and the order dated 11.05.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
