Case heard via video conferencing.

By this petition, the petitioners seek protection of life and liberty at the hands of respondents no. 4 and 5, who are their daughter and her paramour respectively (as alleged).

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that though the petitioners' daughter is of the age of majority and therefore they may not have anything to say with regard to her having eloped with her paramour and sought protection of this court vide CRWP No. 2909 of 2021, which was disposed of on 24.03.2021, by giving a direction to the Superintendent of Police, Sirsa, to dispose of the representation made by her daughter and her paramour (as contended), as per law; yet the petitioners are also now receiving threats from their daughter, as also the paramour and his family, i.e. respondents no. 4 and 5 (and family of respondent no. 5), to transfer property in the name of their daughter, failing which the daughter would be forced to commit suicide.

He further submits that the mobile numbers from which they are receiving phone calls are given in paragraph no. 7 of the petition.

Learned counsel next submits that as a matter of fact at this stage the petitioners would be satisfied if the petition is disposed of with a direction to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, to go into the grievance of the petitioners and take action as per law after duly verifying the fact that they have been receiving calls from the aforesaid mobile numbers.

Consequently, without making any comment as is contended hereinabove, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana (respondent no. 2), to go into the grievance of the petitioners and if any substance is found in the allegations of threats made to them, naturally, action would be taken as per law by the Commissioner immediately thereafter.

It is again clarified however that this court has not made any observation whatsoever on the contentions raised in the petition.
