The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioners seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.94 dated 30.03.2021 registered under Sections 147, 149, 323, 325, 427, 452 IPC and Section 3 of SC/ST Act, at Police Station Agroha, District Hisar.

On 24.06.2021, following order was passed:-

“The matter has been taken up through video conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

It is inter-alia contended that the parties being at loggerhead have entered into a scuffle and false allegations have been levelled against the petitioners and noting is to be recovered.

Notice of motion for 10.08.2021.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of arresting/investigating officer. The petitioners shall, however,

join the investigation within a period of 15 days and shall also abide by the conditions specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

On 10.08.2021, learned State counsel submitted that petitioner No.2 had not joined the investigation. Petitioner No.1 had joined the investigation but he had not rendered any cooperation to the investigating officer. Petitioners were again directed to join the investigation.

Today, learned State counsel on instructions from DSP Abhimanyu Lohan submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer and they are no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of the aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 24.06.2021 is made absolute. Petitioners shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and they shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
