The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.23 dated 13.3.2021 registered under Sections 354, 323, 379, 452/34 IPC registered at Police Station Rangar Nangal, District Gurdaspur.

By virtue of the order dated 12.5.2021, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Amarjeet Singh, has endorsed the same and submitted that petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

Learned counsel for the complainant has vehemently opposed the prayer of the petitioner and has submitted that the petitioner is not entitled to be released on anticipatory bail.

In view of the above, the order dated 12.5.2021 is made absolute and the petition stands allowed.
