The case has been taken up for hearing through
video conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail under Section
439 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.480 dated 07.12.2020,
registered under Section 22(c)/27-A of NDPS Act at Police
Station Sadar Fatehabad, District Fatehabad.

Co-accused David son of Kikar Singh was found in
possession of 1200 Alprazolam tablets total weighing 252

grams.

During investigation, co-accused made a disclosure statement that the contraband was supplied by the petitioner.

Learned State counsel submits that the petitioner is also involved in one case under Excise Act and one case under Section 304-A IPC. He is not involved in any other case under NDPS Act.

Since the petitioner has been nominated on the basis of disclosure statement of co-accused, application of Section 37 of NDPS Act would remain debatable.

No recovery has been effected from the petitioner.

Petitioner is in custody since 03.03.2021.

Looking to the aforesaid facts and in view of the situation arising out due to COVID-19 pandemic and without adverting to the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to enlarge the petitioner on regular bail.

In view of above, petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, subject to his furnishing

adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/concerned Duty Magistrate.

Nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be an expression of any opinion on merits of the case.
