Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 162 dated 28.07.2020, registered under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC, at Police Station Canal Colony Bathinda, District Bathinda.

Vide order dated 12.05.2021 passed by a Coordinate Bench, interim relief was granted to the petitioner.
