MEENAKSHI I. MEHTA, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner herein, who is presently lodged in District Jail Sirsa, in connection with the criminal case arising out of FIR No.32 dated 15.03.2015 registered at Police Station Baragudha, District Sirsa, under Section 21 of NDPS Act, seeks the relief of the issuance of a direction to the respondents to extend his parole for eight more weeks while deciding his representation dated 22.04.2021 (Annexure P-4) so as to enable him to get proper treatment .

Reply, by way of the affidavit of Superintendent, District Prison, Sirsa has already been filed on behalf of the respondent-State in this

petition and its perusal reveals that it has categorically been mentioned in para No.3 thereof, that the petitioner has already surrendered himself in the jail on 12.05.2021 after an over stay of eight days. In view of this fact, the present petition becomes infructuous.

Even otherwise, the representation (Annexure P-4), as moved by the petitioner to respondent No.2, bears the date as 22.04.2021 and the period of eight weeks therefrom has already lapsed.

To add to it, it has also been specifically mentioned in para No.7 of the reply that the petitioner was referred to Civil Hospital Sirsa on 06.06.2021 and 09.07.2021 for his follow up treatment and the plaster/ bandage applied on his right arm has already been removed and the medicines have also been provided to him.

Keeping in view all the above-discussed facts and circumstances, this Court is of the considered opinion that the instant petition deserves dismissal.

Resultantly, the same stands dismissed accordingly.
