The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

The petitioner prays for bail pending trial in FIR No.0081 dated 01.05.2020, registered under Sections 302, 452 and 188 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, at Police Station Sadar Nabha, District Patiala.

As per the case of prosecution, the petitioner shot dead the son of the first informant in his presence.

It is not in dispute that the depositions of all the prosecution witnesses have been recorded except one.

Since the trial of the case has already made substantial progress therefore, there is no occasion to consider the request for grant of bail. However, the Trial Court is requested to make sincere endeavours for conclusion of the trial preferably within three months.

With these observations, the petition is disposed of.
