GIRISH AGNIHOTRI, J.

The present Review Application has been filed by the applicant-petitioner *inter alia* with a prayer to review the order dated 09.03.2021, passed by this Court.

Vide detailed order dated 09.03.2021, the pleas raised by the petitioner at the time of argument, had been dealt with.

Learned counsel for the applicant-petitioner has tried to take a stand by shifting burden upon the respondents. He submits that he had put his signatures at the bottom of the form, whereas, he alleges that form was filled up by the respondents. The petitioner had applied for the post of Multi Tasking (non-technical) Staff in pursuance to advertisement dated

16.11.2013.

The OA No.060/00064 of 2017 filed by the applicant, was dismissed on 08.03.2019 (Annexure P-2) by the Central Administrative Tribunal, Chandigarh. In view of the above, we are of the considered view that such disputed question of fact as alleged by counsel for the petitioner, cannot be gone into. In Condition No.11 of the advertisement, it was clearly mentioned that candidates should send/submit application in the prescribed format to the concerned Regional Office of SSC as mentioned in Para 7 of the Notice or apply online. In the Review Application, no reference has been made to any document vide which the petitioner had allegedly objected to the authorities regarding the fact that he had not filled up the application form himself.

For the reasons aforementioned, we find no merit in the Review Application filed by the applicant-petitioner and the same is dismissed.

No order as to costs.
