This Civil Writ Petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents to pay the unpaid retiral benefits such as gratuity and leave encashment along with 12% interest on account of delay in payment of the same from the date of superannuation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner would be satisfied in case direction is issued to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 08.03.2021 (Annexure P-6) within a stipulated period.
