The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus for directing the respondents to consider the cases of the petitioners for appointment to the posts of Porters/Mazdoors in future, by giving them preference over the other candidates, having rendered service in Kargil War Zone on the analogy appointment order dated 08.03.2017 issued by the respondents, in case of similarly situated persons on the direction of Hon'ble J & K High Court in SWP No.2823 of 2001 titled Ram Lal and others versus Union of India & another decided on 01.01.2010 and was upheld by the Division Bench of Hon'ble J & K High Court in LPA No.64 of 2014 decided on 10.02.2016

The counsel for the respondents has pointed out that the dispute regarding the employment/termination of the services of the petitioners is already pending before the Labour Court at Jalandhar.

In view of the above, this court does not find it appropriate to conduct a parallel proceeding. Hence, the present petition is dismissed, leaving the petitioners at liberty to prosecute their case(s) before the Labour Court at Jalandhar.
