1. This petition has been filed against the order dated 16.04.2021 (Annexure P-11) dismissing the appeal of the petitioner filed against rejection of his technical bid.
2. The preliminary objection raised by the learned Additional Advocate General is that there is a provision for second appeal also.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that there are allegations of serious illegalities in the petition and therefore, even though there is an alternate remedy, this Court should take up this matter. Even though we accept the argument of learned counsel for the petitioner regarding levelling of serious allegations in this case, yet we do not deem it appropriate to entertain this petition and consequently, direct the petitioner to file an appeal before the Principal Secretary, Food, Civil Supplies and Consumers Affairs Department with an advance copy of the appeal to Mr. Suveer Sheokand.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes to file an appeal on or before 17th May, 2021 and in case that is done, the Appellate Authority is directed to decide the same after hearing both the parties on or before 24th May, 2021 by passing a speaking order. Parties are directed to appear before the Tribunal on 18th May, 2021 or any other date Appellate Authority may fix.

5. Petition is disposed of.

6. Since the main case has been decided, the pending Civil Miscellaneous Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
