2. Prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.265 dated 19.06.2020 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Central Faridabad, District Faridabad.

3. Learned counsel contends that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 11.05.2021, the petitioner joined investigation, fully cooperated with the police, was released on ad interim pre arrest bail and that his custodial interrogation is not required.
