At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners have served legal notice Annexure P-11 dated 09.01.2021 in respect of the grievance which is the subject matter of the instant petition but the claim made in the legal notice has not been decided till date and that in the circumstances, the petitioners would be satisfied if the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.1 to consider and decide the claim made in the legal notice Annexure P-11 dated 09.01.2021 in accordance with orders of this Court Annexures P-14 to P-19 dated 23.07.2020, 17.11.2020, 08.02.2021, 22.01.2021, 15.12.2020 and 22.04.2021 respectively.

4. Mr. Aditya Sharda, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice and states that

he has no objection to the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the

petitioners.

Accordingly, in view of the statement of learned counsel for the parties but without commenting upon the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.1 to consider and decide the claim made in legal notice Annexure P-11 dated 09.01.2021 in accordance with law and by taking into account the decisions of this Court as referred to above in case the same are applicable within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and in case of finding the petitioners entitled to the relief claimed, to release the benefits thereof to the petitioners within a period of one month thereafter, failing which the financial benefits shall be paid along with interest at the rate of 6% per annum from the date of entitlement till date of payment.
