HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are working as TGT Teachers in the various schools being run by respondent No.2-Society and though, the promotion policy has already been approved by the competent authority but no promotions are being effected and that too without any valid justification despite availability of vacancies in the promotion cadre, which is causing prejudice to them.

The prayer of the petitioners is for issuance of a direction to respondent No.2 to decide their claim for promotion to the next higher ranks in accordance with law.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that for the relief which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioners have already approached the authority by filing representations dated 16.03.2021 (Annexure P-11) and 24.03.2021 (Annexure P-12) respectively and the petitioners will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound

direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the said representations by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Shubhra Singh, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, who has joined the proceedings through video conference, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1 and raises no objection for deciding the representations of the petitioners in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioners for the relief which has been claimed by them in the representations dated 16.03.2021 (Annexure P-11) and 24.03.2021 (Annexure P-12) respectively, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representations dated 16.03.2021 (Annexure P-11) and 24.03.2021 (Annexure P-12) within a period of three months from the receipt of copy of this order.
