Instant petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the Deputy Commissioner, Ludhiana to decide the complaint (Annexure P-4) dated 14.06.2019 forwarded by the petitioner with the concern that respondents No. 5 and 6 have prepared false Site Map, Aksh Shajra (Annexure P-2) of village Alamgir, Ludhiana and they have illegally usurped the government passage, which was also being used by the petitioner.

After arguing for some time, counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the petition with liberty to avail the remedy available to the petitioner in accordance with law.

Permitted to do so.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
