The petitioner has filed this petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to consider the candidature of the petitioner who is holding the Masters of Science (Forestry) degree and Bachelors of Science (Forestry) for the post of Sub Divisional Engineer (Horticulture) and Junior Engineer (Horticulture) advertised vide recruitment notice No.1857 dated 26.03.2021 (Annexure P-4), along with certain other prayers.

Learned counsel for the respondent No.2 has pointed out that the written examination has already been held and the process of selection is at advance stage of completion.

In view of the above, this court does not find it appropriate to continue with the present petition. Hence the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

However, the issue of the degree of the petitioner, being equivalent with the qualifications prescribed in the concerned rules, is left open.
