Case is taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing.

This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondents No.4 and 5.

In the present case, the petitioner is the father-in-law of Sonia Tyagi, respondent No.4, who has lost his husband Kuldeep Tyagi (who committed suicide on 01.08.2020). It is admitted case of the petitioner that his daughter-in-law Sonia Tyagi, respondent No.4, is residing in her parental home along with her minor son and daughter.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 at this stage.

At the asking of the Court, Sh. Pardeep Prakash Chahar, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.

Undisputedly, respondent No.4, after having lost her husband, is no longer residing at her matrimonial home. It denies common understanding as to how and in which manner, the petitioner is

apprehending danger from a hapless widowed lady. It appears that in order to deny respondent No.4 and her minor children, their share in the property of his son-Kuldeep Tyagi, the petitioner is projecting a self styled danger to his life, when there exists none. This course of action is totally uncalled for and rather establishes a mala-fide on the part of the petitioner himself.

In view of the above, the petition is dismissed with costs of Rs.10,000/- to be deposited with the Poor Patients' Welfare Fund of the Post Graduate Institute of Medical Education and Research (PGIMER), Chandigarh.
