This is a petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the illegal suspension of licence order dated 05.03.2021 (Annexure P-7), with a further prayer to declare the above said suspension order as having been automatically revoked as per sub section 11 (4) of the Punjab Substance Use Disorder Treatment and Counselling Rehabilitation Centre Rules or to stay the above said impugned order dated 05.03.2021.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that vide subsequent order, the respondents have kept the order of suspension of the licence of the petitioner in abeyance till further reconsideration. Hence, the present petition be permitted to be withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to approach the Court again, if any adverse order against the petitioner is revived or freshly passed by the respondents.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
