Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to appoint the petitioner in Government service with all consequential benefits as per Policy dated 08.11.2011 (P-1), which was amended by way of guidelines dated 28.02.2014 (P-5) against the land acquired for Thermal Plant at Village Gobindpura, District Mansa.

At the outset, learned Counsel on instructions from the petitioner submits that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case the Legal Notice dated 02.07.2020 (P-10) is considered and decided expeditiously.

Learned State Counsel raises no objection against the innocuous prayer of the petitioner.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.3-Deputy Commissioner, Mansa to consider and decide the aforesaid Legal Notice 02.07.2020 (P-10) in accordance with law by passing speaking order preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
