After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners prays that she has instructions to withdraw the present petition with liberty to pursue the remedy which the petitioners have already availed before the Labour Court as the same is already pending consideration before the authorities concerned. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners will move an appropriate application before the authorities concerned to expediate their claim for early decision as the same is causing prejudice to the petitioners.

The present petition is allowed to be withdrawn with liberty to the petitioners to pursue the remedy which the petitioners have already availed before the Labour Court. In case, the petitioners approach the

Labour Court for early disposal of their claim, this Court has no apprehension that appropriate consideration will be given to the said application by the authorities concerned.
