Case has been taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing.

This Civil Writ Petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been moved for issuance of writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to count the daily wage as Special Police Officer (SPO) service of petitioners, rendered before their respective regularization as qualifying service for the purpose of pensionary/retiral benefits.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Sahil Sharma, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

Learned counsel for the petitioners at the very outset contended that petitioners would be satisfied in case direction is issued to the
