Case taken up through video conferencing.

Status report by way of affidavit of DSP, Adampur, Jalandhar (Rural) filed, which be taken on record. Inter alia, in the status report, it has been mentioned in para No.13 that in the cross version, accused Gobind Singh, Gurpreet Pal Singh (present petitioner) and Sukhwinder Singh have been ordered to be challaned under Section 341, 323 and 34 IPC. All these offences are bailable, therefore, this petition for pre-arrest bail filed by petitioner Gurpreet Pal Singh has become infructuous.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in case at any stage, if the petitioner is required to be arrested for some non-bailable offence, then the investigating agency should give prior notice to the

petitioner to enable him to seek his legal remedy.

Ld. State counsel, on instructions from SI Amrik Singh states that in case the petitioner is required to be arrested for any non-bailable offence at any stage of this case, then the police would give 07 days prior notice to him.

With such observations, the petition is dismissed as infructuous.
