Prayer in this petition is for cancellation of anticipatory bail granted to respondent No. 2 as well as regular bail granted to respondent Nos. 3 to 7 in case FIR No. 125 dated 18.06.2017, registered under Sections 302/336/353/186/148 & 149 IPC read with Section 27/54/59 of Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Cantonment, District Amritsar.

This petition is pending since 2019. There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner. Even on the last date of hearing, none appeared on behalf of the petitioner.

Learned State counsel submits that the complainant has already been examined before the trial Court and all the accused are regularly appearing before the trial Court. It is further submitted that out of 45 prosecution witnesses, 6 witnesses have been examined and the accused have not misused the concession of bail.

In view of the above, considering the fact that since a period of more than 2 years has lapsed and there is no allegation that the accused have ever misused the concession of anticipatory bail/regular bail, I find no ground to cancel the bail granted to them.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
