The matter has been taken up through video conferencing.

Learned counsel for the petitioner as also the complainant submit that the present FIR which originated on the basis of a matrimonial dispute between the petitioner and the complainant has since been amicably resolved and on the basis thereof, a petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 has already been filed before the Competent Court.

In the light of the above development and for the reason that the petitioner is attributed a simple injury on the non-vital part of the body, subject to the petitioner's joining investigation as and when called by the investigating agency as also abiding by the other condition provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C., in the even of his arrest in FIR No.167 dated 02.10.2019 registered under Sections 341/324/323/326/148/149/120-B IPC at Police Station Kotbhai, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, he shall be released on anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer.

The present petition is allowed in the above terms.
