SUDIP AHLUWALIA, J. (ORAL)

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure by the petitioners, seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.20 dated 25.03.2021, under Sections 326, 324, 323, 341, 148 and 149 of the IPC (Section 326 of the IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Shri Hargobindpur, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur, Punjab.

2. Seen MLR of the victim (Annexure P-2), as also the General Diary Details pertaining to injury Nos. 1 and 2 suffered by the said victim, which were subsequently found to be grievous in nature. The victim had faced assault at the hands of both the petitioners together. So, it would not be very

material as to which particular injury was inflicted by any one of the two assailants or whether all the injuries attributed to any individual petitioner were found to be simple in nature.

3. This Court, therefore, finds no ground to grant the extra-ordinary relief of anticipatory bail to the petitioners as Ld. State Counsel has submitted that the weapons of offence are yet to be recovered, for which their custodial interrogation is required.

4. Dismissed.
