JAISHREE THAKUR, J. (Oral)

This is a petition that has been filed for grant of regular bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.59 dated 25.11.2020 under Sections 364-A, 323, 341 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Mohindergarh, District Narnaul.

Learned counsel for the petitioners would contend that the petitioners have been falsely implicated in the said matter. It is argued that all allegations regarding abduction for ransom are false. The investigation has been completed and the challan stands presented. The trial is likely to

take some time to conclude, therefore, prayer is made for concession of regular bail to the petitioners.

Appearance has been made on behalf of the complainant by Mr. Mahender Singh Chahal, Advocate, who admits to the factum of matter being compromised.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties. Keeping in view the fact that the matter has been compromised between the parties to the dispute and the trial is likely to take some time to conclude, as owing to COVID-19 pandemic, no useful purpose would be served in keeping the petitioners behind bars. The instant petition is allowed and the petitioners are directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal/ surety bond to the satisfaction of concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate. However, any observation made herein shall not be construed to be an expression on merits of the case.
