On 13.05.2021, this Court passed the following order:-

“The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 Pandemic.

Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 53 dated 06.03.2021 under Sections 323, 341, 506 and 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 325 and 308 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 were added later on, registered at Police Station Phillaur, District Jalandhar Rural.

Counsel for the petitioner has urged that injury attracting offence under Section 308 IPC has been attributed to his brother, namely, Chaman Lal @ Ravi. Counsel submits that though there are injuries attributed to the petitioner but none of them have been declared to be dangerous to life.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Saurav Khurana, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

List on 08.09.2021.

Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, he shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting Investigating Officer. He shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. ”

Learned State counsel, upon instructions, from ASI Sukhwinder Pal Singh submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no longer required for custodial interrogation. He has further instructions to state that the petitioner is not involved in any other criminal case.

In view of the above fact, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. Order dated 13.05.2021 is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
