The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.11 dated 24.02.2019 under Sections 406 and 498-A of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Nurmahal, District Jalandhar

As per report received from the Mediation and Conciliation Center of this Court, the parties have failed to arrive at an amicable settlement.

It was the case of the petitioner that on account of a matrimonial dispute between her son and the complainant, the FIR in question was got registered wherein false allegations had been levelled by the complainant against the accused including the petitioner of subjecting her to harassment for not getting sufficient dowry.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order dated 12.02.2020, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Jasvir Singh has apprised the Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 12.02.2020, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.
