By means of this writ petition under Article 226 Constitution of India, petitioners have prayed for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect their life and liberty, as they are apprehending threats at the hands of private respondent Nos.4 to 7.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has argued that the respondents are threatening the petitioners, as they are living together in live-in relationship and in this regard, a representation dated 10.03.2021 (Annexure P-4) has already been given to the Superintendent of Police, Nuh Mewat, however, till date no protection has been provided to them. He prays for issuance of necessary directions.

After hearing the learned counsel, this Court finds that admittedly, the petitioner No.2 was earlier married to Kalu Khan and has two children. Though, it is pleaded in the petition that she has obtained divorce from her husband, but no document in support of the plea has been placed on record, except her affidavit (Annexure P-3) and the same is also

without any date or particulars, therefore, this alone is not enough to lend strength to the case of petitioners.

Even otherwise, it is the case of the petitioners that they are residing together in live-in relationship, whereas the representation submitted before respondent No.2 contains the fact that they solemnized marriage on 10.02.2021. Further, a perusal of representation does not reveal the mode or manner of alleged threat extended to the petitioners, and apparently, the petition is without convincing cause of action.

Resultantly, no ground is made out for invoking extra ordinary writ jurisdiction under Article 226 Constitution of India.

Dismissed.
