The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioners have prayed for issuance of necessary direction to protect their lives and personal liberties from being invaded at the instance of the private respondents. Petitioners are alleged to have solemnized marriage on 26.04.2021 on attaining the age of majority. They feel reasonable apprehension and threat perception at the hands of the private respondents and pray that their personal/civil rights be not violated by them.

Earlier representation dated 27.04.2021 was submitted personally but thereafter the same was also sent through courier before Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur on 12.05.2021.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Amar Ashok Pathak, Addl., A.G, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of State-

respondents No.1 to 3.

At this stage, without meaning anything in the context of validity of marriage and majority of the petitioners, it would be just and appropriate to direct respondent No.2 to look into the grievance of the petitioners and pass an appropriate order on merits in accordance with law. Respondent No.2 would pass necessary order without being influenced by any pleadings made in the petition.

This order shall not debar the official respondents from proceeding against any of the parties, if they are involved in any other case. It would be appreciated if the needful is done within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
