Seen the Status Report sent up today through E-mail in the form of Affidavit of the Senior Superintendent of Police, District Amritsar (Rural), on behalf of Respondent No.3. In Para No.7 thereof, it has been mentioned that FIR No.159 dated 03.05.2021 under Sections 376, 363, 342, 458 of the IPC and Section 4 of the POCSO Act, has already been registered at Police Station Ajnala against the private Respondents after which the Detenue has already been recovered and her custody has been handed over to the Child Welfare Committee, District Amritsar (Rural).

2. In view of the aforesaid developments, Ld. Counsel for the Petitioner submits that the present Writ Petition, may be treated as infructuous since the Detenue has already been recovered from the illegal custody of the private Respondents.

3. The Writ Petition is therefore disposed off as having been rendered infructuous.
