Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioners in GD No.28 dated 6.3.2021 registered under Sections 324, 148, 149 IPC (later on added section 326 I.P.C) (in FIR No.35 dated 5.3.2021 under sections 323, 325, 354, 452, 295, 148, 149 I.P.C) at Police Station, Tanda, District Hoshiarpur.

By virtue of the order dated 11.5.2021, the petitioners were directed to join investigation.
