The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for the grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 0010, dated 15.01.2021, registered under Sections 323, 148, 149, 506 IPC (Sections 325, 307, 459 IPC added later on) at Police Station Fattudhinga, District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that she is not pressing the present petition on merits but only prays that an appropriate direction be issued to the trial Court to examine the complainant as the first witness.

Learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for the complainant raises no objection for the said prayer.
