Grievance of the petitioner is that adequate supply of oxygen is
not being granted to it which is resulting in patients turning critical.
Learned counsel submits that regarding his grievance, he has also made a
representation dated 4.5.2021 (Annexure P-4).

Mr. Mahajan submits that the grievance of the petitioner shall

be looked into by the District Level Monitoring Committee and an effort shall be made to supply oxygen subject to availability thereof of the total oxygen quota allocated to the State of Haryana.

In view of the statement made, no further direction is necessary. Petition is hereby disposed of. If any grouse subsists, the petitioner shall be at liberty to move afresh.
