1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has submitted representation (Annexure P-5) dated 03.03.2021 for registration of FIR against respondent Nos.4 to 7 but no action has been taken on the same and that in the circumstances, the petitioner would be satisfied, if the petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide representation (Annexure P-5) dated 03.03.2021 and take such action in respect thereto, as may be warranted, in accordance with law.

3. Notice to respondent No.2 only.

4. Mr. Hittan Nehra, learned Addl. Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice and states that he has no objection to the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

5. Accordingly, without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is *disposed of* by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide representation (Annexure P-5) dated 03.03.2021 and take such action in respect thereto if any, as may be warranted, in accordance with law.

6. Petition disposed of with the aforementioned directions.
