The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.213 dated 16.09.2018 registered under Sections 306 and 506 IPC, at Police Station City Faridkot.

Petitioner has been summoned under Section 319 Cr.P.C vide order dated 13.05.2021. Notice of motion was issued and the petitioner was directed to appear before the trial Court on 05.07.2021 and in the event of his appearance he was to be granted interim bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

On 13.05.2021, following order was passed:-

"The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was found innocent during course of investigation. He

has been summoned under Section 319 Cr.P.C. FIR was registered on 16.09.2018 under Sections 306, 506 IPC against Joban Singh @ Partap Singh, Rajinder Singh @ Raja and Babbu Singh at the instance of the complainant namely Maya Rani. Rahul committed suicide by hanging himself with the ceiling fan. Petitioner was declared innocent and challan was presented only against Joban Singh @ Partap Singh and Rajinder Singh @ Raja. They have been granted anticipatory bail by the High Court vide order dated 14.02.2019 passed in CRM-M No.48278 of 2018 and CRM-M No.4067 of 2019.

Notice of motion for 05.08.2021.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to appear before the trial Court on 05.07.2021, i.e. the date already fixed and in the event of his appearance, he shall be granted interim bail on his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds subject to the satisfaction of trial Court.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court on 05.07.2021 and has been granted interim bail by the trial Court to its satisfaction.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Iqbal Singh admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 13.05.2021 is made absolute. However, petitioner shall keep on appearing before the trial Court regularly.

Petition stands disposed of.
