The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.184, dated 02.09.2020, under Sections 376-D, 506 and 120-B of the IPC and Sections 5 and 6 of the POCSO Act registered at Police Station Division No.3, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that in compliance of order dated 13.05.2021, the petitioner appeared before the trial Court concerned and thereafter he was admitted to interim bail.

Learned State counsel on instructions does not dispute the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner.
