MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (Oral)

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in case FIR No.132, dated 26.05.2020, under Sections 409, 420, 467, 468 and 471 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Kosli, District Rewari.

A status report by way of an affidavit of Mohinder Singh, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Kosli, District Rewari has been filed on behalf of the respondent-State in Court through e-mail. Same is taken on record, subject to all just exceptions.

Learned State counsel has submitted that pursuant to the orders dated 22.06.2020 and 29.09.2020 passed by this Court, no doubt the petitioner did join investigation, however, he has not been co-operating with the investigating agency.

The learned counsel for the complainant who has also put in

appearance through video conferencing, has opposed the prayer for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. He has submitted that in fact two cheques amounting to Rs.5.00 lakhs and Rs.4.00 lakhs (Annexure R-2/1), which were issued by the brother of the petitioner pursuant to a compromise which was effected between the parties, were dishonoured on account of insufficient funds.

Heard.

In the facts and circumstances of the case and keeping in view the antecedents of the petitioner, no ground is made out to extend the extraordinary concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.
