Learned State counsel submits that the award dated 7.5.2007 was passed and the compensation assessed by the Sub-Divisional Magistrate-cum-competent authority was disbursed in the year 2008.

In view of the above, the land has vested in the acquiring authority i.e. National Highway Authority of India free from all encumbrances. The petitioner has no right and title to the acquired land. Thus, the writ petition is dismissed as being not maintainable.
