The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 0189 dated 07.04.2021 under Sections 34, 354, 377, 406, 498-A IPC registered at Police Station Sampla, District Rohtak, Haryana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner herein would contend that pursuant to order dated 12.05.2021 petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent-State on instructions from ASI Mamtesh submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation purposes as he has been found innocent in the matter.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation

and is not required by the police for custodial interrogation the instant petition is allowed and the order dated 12.05.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
