The petitioners have been appointed as JBT Teachers on ad hoc basis by virtue of interim order passed by this Court. They were selected as Primary Teachers, pursuant to an advertisement issued in the year 2012, however, on account of pending litigation, their services were terminated. Under threat of contempt, the State of Haryana has appointed them on ad hoc basis.

The present writ petition has been filed challenging the notice dated 30.4.2021 (Annexure P-11), whereby, preferences for temporary posting of JBT Teachers, who were appointed in 2017 and onwards against advertisement No.2/2012 have been sought.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners would be relieved from their jobs under the garb of the aforementioned notice of transfer.

Notice of motion.

Mr. N.S. Behgal, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice and waives service.

Learned State counsel categorically submits that impugned notice dated 30.4.2021 does not amount to termination of services of the petitioners. The petitioners are not going to be relieved from their jobs and thus, their apprehension is mis-placed.

In view of the submission of learned State counsel, nothing survives for adjudication in this writ petition and the same is disposed of.
