Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for setting aside the order dated 25.07.2016 passed by learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gurdaspur in FIR case No.72 dated 07.06.2016 registered under Sections 498/406/328/120-B of IPC and under Section 3 of Dowry prohibition Act, 1961. Direction has also been sought to release the passport of the petitioner which has been impounded by the police authority during investigation.
