This petition has been filed by the petitioner alleging that the respondents are not taking action against respondent No.6 who has set up an illegal brick kiln in a residential colony inspite of the fact that the orders have been passed by the Sub Divisional Magistrate, Kharar, District SAS Nagar, Mohali on 28.12.2020.

Learned Deputy Advocate General appearing for the respondent-State of Punjab submits that the proceedings are already pending before the Sub Divisional Magistrate, Kharar and respondent No.6 has now entered appearance before him. He further submits that the next date of hearing before the Sub Divisional Magistrate, Kharar, is 24.05.2021, on which date necessary and appropriate orders will be passed in accordance with law.

In view of the above, as the matter is already pending before the Sub Divisional Magistrate, Kharar, who is dealing with the same and parallel proceedings cannot be permitted to be taken up by the petitioner, the petition is disposed of taking the aforesaid statement of learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab on record and observing that the respondent-authorities may proceed with the matter in accordance with law expeditiously.

It is made clear that this Court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the case and therefore, the respondent-authorities would be at liberty to examine the matter keeping all facts and facets into consideration and thereafter accept or reject the same in accordance with law.
