1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

2. Prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.31 dated 27.03.2021, registered under Sections 307, 148, 149 of IPC, 1860 and 25, 27 Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Sadar Patti, District Tarn Taran.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the injury attributed to the petitioner by 12 bore rifle on the right hand of the complainant and neck & right arm of Jugraj Singh are simple in nature and as per medical opinion, the same are attributed to gunfire shots, besides, the matter has been amicably resolved between the parties by way of compromise (Annexure P-2) dated 05.04.2021, and petition for quashing of compromise i.e. CRM-M-16143 of 2021 has also been filed in which while accepting notice of motion, counsel on behalf of the complainants had stated that he had no objection if the aforementioned

FIR and all consequential proceedings emanating therefrom were quashed in view of compromise (Annexure P-2) dated 05.04.2021.

4. Today, learned counsel for the petitioner contends while learned State Counsel on instructions from *SI Nirmal Singh*, confirms that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 20.07.2021, the petitioner joined investigation, cooperated in the same, was released on ad-interim pre-arrest bail and his custodial interrogation is not required.

5. In view of the statement of the learned State Counsel, order dated 20.07.2021, passed by this Court, is made absolute. The petitioner shall abide by the terms and conditions enumerated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. However, nothing stated hereinabove shall be deemed to be an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.

6. Petition stands disposed of in the aforementioned terms.
