The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for directing respondent No.1 to 4 to conduct a fair and impartial investigation. In substance, the petitioner alleges that respondent No.5 and 6 have purchased land measuring 4 kanals with a construction thereupon by undervaluing the amount of the sale consideration in order to cheat the public exchequer of stamp duty.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the remedy for the petitioner lies under the Registration Act. Hence, the petition is disposed of and the petitioner is relegated to the alternative remedy.
