AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioners have approached this Court with a grievance that they are entitled to the benefit of the water supply and sewerage as well as other facilities as per the policy issued by the Haryana Urban Development Authority (now Haryana Shahari Vikas Pradhikaran) dated 19.04.2017 (Annexure P-6). In pursuance thereto, the petitioners have approached the respondents by way of various representations, the latest being addressed to the Chief Administrator, HSVP, Panchkula, on 10.02.2021 (Annexure P-11). He, however, asserts that the petitioners would file a separate comprehensive representation within a period of one week to the Chief Administrator, Haryana Shahari Vikas Pradhikaran, Panchkula-respondent No.2, which may be considered and decided within some specified time.

2. Notice of motion.

3. On the asking of the Court, Ms. Shubhra Singh, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, puts in appearance on behalf of the respondents.

4. Keeping in view the prayer made by the petitioners and their counsel, as has been recorded above, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to file separate comprehensive representations for seeking relief of their grievances, as has been sought to be highlighted in the present writ petition in the light of the policy dated 19.04.2017 (Annexure P-6) within a period of one week.

5. If such a representation is made to the Chief Administrator, Haryana Shahari Vikas Pradhikaran, Panchkula-respondent No.2, the same shall be considered and a decision taken thereon within a period of six weeks in accordance with law.

6. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioners forthwith.
