All the petitioners have joined hands to prefer this petition for seeking the indulgence of this Court for the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the official respondents to protect their life and liberty as they (petitioners) apprehend threat to the same at the hands of respondents No.5 and 6, and they have averred that petitioner No.1 had taken the loan of Rs.18.5 lacs from respondents No.5 and 6 but these respondents are extorting money from him on the pretext of the repayment thereof despite the fact that he has already paid a total sum of Rs.1.2 crores to them and they are also threatening the petitioners on their raising an objection for the same. It has also been mentioned in this petition that petitioner No.1 has already moved a representation (Annexure P-1) to respondent No.3 in this regard.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only.

Mr. Amit Aggarwal, learned Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, who has joined the proceedings on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4 in this case in pursuance of the copies of this petition having been sent to the respondent-State in advance, accepts the notice on behalf of these respondents.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioners restricts his prayer to the issuance of a direction to respondent No.3 to take appropriate action on the said representation of petitioner No.1, i.e. Annexure P-1.

Learned counsel for the State has no objection to the same.

Without expressing any opinion on the allegations/averments as canvassed by the petitioners in this petition, respondent No.3-Commissioner of Police, Panchkula, District Panchkula, is hereby directed to look into the said representation (Annexure P-1) of petitioner No.1 and if it is found that the petitioners genuinely deserve any protection, then to take appropriate action in accordance with law.

This petition stands disposed of accordingly.
